Dear parents/carers

Term 3 has been a big one. We have had a big term filled with highlights. These include daily learning in classrooms, our STEM festival, first Book Swap, a successful walkathon and most recently, excellent presentations by our teams in the *Tournament of Minds* finals, with one team now heading to Adelaide for the next level of competition. We have welcomed nine new students and four new staff. Today, we also farewell, Jeff Suptut who has taught chess across the school and supported our teams in competitions. Jeff's association with chess at Curtin has spanned decades, and we thank him for his contribution. We look forward to continuing with chess in 2018, with a new coach to be sought.

At a whole school level, planning for 2018 is well underway. This occurs through reflecting on student learning results, considering student wellbeing approaches and through a range of surveys to gather information from students, staff and families. Many families will be looking for opportunities to give information about their child with relation to their progress, class placement or social learning. At this point, we encourage the first step of communicating with your class teacher to discuss your child's progress learning in term 4 and into 2018.

At a general level, I would like to thank the families who have contributed to the surveys regarding our PALs program, and the *School Satisfaction Survey*. Year 2: AQUA SAFE

Curtin Primary School is excited to be offering Year 2 students the opportunity to acquire essential life skills in water safety and survival through Royal Life Saving ACT. **It is our aim to have 100% participation.**

The ACT Education and Training Directorate provides substantial funding for Year 2 students in ACT Public Schools to participate in the Royal Life Saving ACT *Aqua Safe* program – a series of 10 practical and 5 theory lessons focussed on general water safety and personal aquatic survival skills. This targeted approach will ensure every participating student has the opportunity to access structured aquatic activities during primary school.

PLEASE NOTE: These are not 'swimming lessons' they are survival skills

The cost of the program is \$50 per student.

Kindergarten, Year 1, Year 3 & 4: SWIM AND SURVIVE

Swim and survive is a comprehensive swimming and water safety initiative of Royal Life Saving that seeks to increase the swimming and water safety skills of all Australian children to prevent drowning and increase participation in safe aquatic activity.

The cost of the program is \$106 per student.
