They might need some help with the preparation of the stall and will be compiling a roster for helpers on the night.


The more helpers we get, the easier it is and it really is loads of fun.

**Donate what you can.** Each stall is looking for donations to help out. Please read through the notices to see what you can help out with and where you can drop it off.




Our amazing Preschoolers are looking after the cake stall this year. They will be distributing plates to the children for donations closer to the Fair.


# Bring In Your Coins

### **Book donations needed!!**


Like every year, space is a premium, and sorting book donations prior to the Fair is a huge task.



## Plant Stall
