Thanks to those parents who have already put their names down to help at their class stalls.



Please contact the class coordinators if you can help, no matter which class your children are in!




Reminders:

- Leave neatly outside the canteen separated from White Elephant






Bring In Your Coins

Fairy Floss and Sweet Stall


FAIRY FLOSS & HOMEMADE SWEETS




Plant Stall
