Cleaning Procedures

Policy statement: All measures are taken to provide a safe and hygienic environment.

This policy should be read in conjunction with Curtin Primary School's Cleaning Contract Schedule of cleaning.

Rationale: The cleaning of the Preschool is an important part of minimising cross infection of diseases. With the use of cleaning aids, specific cleaning tools and regular cleaning we aim to provide a sanitised environment.

Strategies, practices and procedures:

- Purchase materials, equipment, toys and other products that are easy to maintain and clean.
- Encourage discussions of health and hygiene as part of the program.
- Educators model correct hygiene procedures.
- Health and hygiene information is provided for parents through brochures (i.e. immunisation requirements, how to prevent the spread of colds and flu and treatment of head lice.)
- Children eat from their own lunch box; no food is shared at Preschool unless it is part of a well supervised and coordinated cooking and tasting experience.
- Cleaners employed at Curtin Primary School supply chemical material safety data sheets (MSDS) for the products used and these are available to view where chemicals are stored at preschool.
- Any maintenance issues are reported to the Building Services Officer (BSO) and are responded to promptly.
