Welcome to term 3 - another busy term.

I hope everyone was able to have a relaxing holiday.

With the COVID situation always changing we would like to remind parents that they must sign in with the QR code at the school gates if they are getting out of the car at drop-off and pickup times.

We also ask that if you are coming to the school for any reason during the day you must sign in via the QR code at the front office. Please don't enter through any other doors during school time. The front office will ensure any students who need to be picked up early will be ready at the front office. However, they need more than 5 minutes notice, as they are very busy. The before school routines have not changed. K-2 students should still be entering via the toilet doors, washing their hands, putting their bags away in their bag boxes and returning to the junior playground. No one should be staying inside.

Senior students should also be sanitising their hands, putting their bags in their bag boxes and then returning outside. No one should be in the corridors and Chromebooks should stay safely in schoolbags. Please remind your children about these routines.

We are still encouraging parents to let their children do this independently.

PBL (Positive Behaviours for Learning) is an essential part of our behaviour management policy. Students are rewarded with coins for displaying safety, respect and being a learner. When students get 10 coins they trade them in for a Curtin certificate. Unfortunately we are getting very low in our coin supply as the students are taking them home and keeping them there. Could all coins be returned to school as soon as possible so we can continue to reward our wonderful students.

In Term 3 we have ILP (Individual learning plan) reviews for all students on ILPs. Each year we have trialled different ways to make these as efficient and informative as possible. We currently have nearly 60 students on ILPs. This year we will be having full formal ILP reviews only for students on ISP or in the LSU. Class teachers will contact you to update ILPs for students who are not in ISP or the LSU. If you would like to organise a meeting with your class teacher to review your child's ILP then please contact them via email.


