The students have been discussing the **Rings of Responsibility** and looking at some of the everyday responsibilities they have, to themselves, to their friends and family, and to the larger community.

- **Self:** The centre ring has to do with responsibilities students have to themselves, such as keeping themselves safe and healthy, and protecting their reputations.
- **Friends and Family**: The middle ring stands for responsibilities students have to their friends and family, such as helping with chores, attending their performances, or just listening to them when they are having problems.
- Larger Community: The outer ring stands for responsibilities to the larger community, from following rules at school to playing safely at the playground.

They then related this to their online Rings of Responsibility including:

- I protect my passwords.
- I stand up to cyberbullying.
- I post my opinions respectfully.
- I give credit for information I find online.
- I get permission to post photos of others.
- I keep my private information private.
